"Dream Forest", a large-sized park surrounded by six districts in Seoul including Gangbuk, Seongbuk and Dobong, is a green park established

over a 660,000m2 land where Dream Land once existed, and it is the third largest park in the city followed by World Cup Park and Olympic Park.

Encircled by thickly wooded Byeogosan and Opaesan Mountains boasting beautiful sceneries, "Dream Forest" features ecological landscaped spaces including cherry blossom road and maple forest. You can also enjoy traditional views of a large pond called Moon Reflecting Pond and

Moonlight Falls, a 49.7m-high observatory providing a clear view of Bukhansan, Dobongsan and Suraksan Mountains all at once. High-quality

cultural and artistic performances of various genres take place all year long in "Dream Forest Arts Center" in its performance hall, exhibition hall, restaurants and observation tower. Dream Forest will come to you as a global park that represents Seoul. Another representative park of Seoul





Culture Plaza

It serves as a front yard of Dream Forest Arts Center and supports diverse cultural activities. It consists of Mirror Pond on which the beauty of the arts center is reflected, Jumping Fountain, Sangsang Children's Playground that helps grow children's imaginative power, Hope Forest (sculptures) containing people's hopes and wishes, and Ball Plaza (multi-purpose square) used to host various

Visitors Center, which is located by the main entrance (East Gate) of the park and has one underground and two ground floors, serves to manage the entire park. Visitors Center also has convenience facilities (nursing room, wheelchairs and strollers rental, etc.).






Seven Waterfall Pond

2 Seven Waterfall Pond

Seven Waterfall Pond creates a scenery with seven different-sized waterfalls that flow along mountain streams formed by height difference. It is an ecological pond where you can enjoy the view of falling water and beautiful aquatic plants live in diverse shapes. Nine bridges are established over the inclined waterfalls, and silver grass and birch roads are set up near weathered rocks showing traces of time. Weeping cherry trees lined up over a vast grass field tell us when spring is coming.









History Garden

History Garden has re-interpreted traditional sceneries to reenact our ancestors' lives and allow us to experience them. It is consisted of "Changnyeongwigung

Ancestral Shrine" (Registered Cultural Heritage No. 40), "Bamboo Forest", "Moon

Light Deck", "Moon Love Pavilion" and "Stone Bridge", all of which exude tranquil

flavors of nature. In the Children's Forest Experience Center, kids are able to run

around and experience as much as they want. You can enjoy the changes of nature

on the trail decorated by cherry blossoms in spring and maple leaves in fall.

Dream Forest Arts Center near West Gate is located in the midst of vast nature of about 6,6km2 and comprises performance venues(performance hall, concert hall) where you become one with nature as well as Dream Gallery, restaurants and cafes. "Dream Forest Arts Center" in which arts and culture meet with nature will be the place where people's lives and dreams come together to form a grand forest.

> The Observatory serves to highlight the image of be gravitated towards, It is a romantic venue where you can view the entire city of Seoul; once you climb up to the 497m-tall observatory equivalent to a three-storied building, the beauty of Bukhansan, Dobongsan and Suraksan Mountains in the north as well as Namsan Mountain and Hangang River in the south unfolds before your eyes like a panorama.

"Moon Reflecting Pond", a large-sized pond located in the center of the park and featuring "Moon Love Pavilion", and 7m-tall "Moonlight Falls", offers coolness of a vast pond, freshness of the waterfall and Korean traditional vibes. Also, there are a colony of bola cypress that grows in water, Yeonji with lotus flowers in Jungdo and Bangjiwondo styles, and Maedae where you can enjoy a view of apricot

31 Botanic Garden

On a land where a golf course had once existed, a parking area with 300 berths was built in the lower section while a solar energy generation facility was installed on the rooftop to generate energy. You can enjoy a clear, panoramic view of the park at the connecting deck located at the end of the upper section. On other parts of the land, a variety of plants and wild flowers including silver grass as well as large trees such as birch are planted to present colorful looks in all four seasons.
